HAZARDOUS WASTE INSPECTION CHECKLIST

	Know what your inspector will be looking for It's important to understand what is going to be evaluated during an inspection. You can ask your inspector for a checklist at any time.	PRO TIP: • Many states publish their inspection checklists online.
	Review your waste determinations Determinations should be readily available. Make sure they are consistent with the generation process.	COMMON VIOLATIONS: • Waste determinations are missing, incomplete, or out-of-date
	Review your manifests Make sure to have all of your destination facility copies. If required, have LDRs available.	COMMON VIOLATIONS: Missing, incomplete, or incorrect waste codes or DOT descriptions on manifests Missing destination facility copies of manifests
	Pull together documentation Include waste reports and notifications for the last 3 calendar years, site inspections, and training records.	COMMON VIOLATIONS: Reports, notifications, or training records are incomplete or unavailable Missing, incomplete, or incorrect Land Disposal Restrictions
	Inspect your waste storage areas Verify signage, look at storage containers, and review any other storage requirements.	COMMON VIOLATIONS: • Labels missing information, ineligible • Open containers • Satellite locations not qualified
Ever Tasl	You can make your own program checklist to audit internally. Be sure to review your statespecific requirements regularly.	In case you aren't available during an inspection, make sure someone else on-site is knowledgeable.
